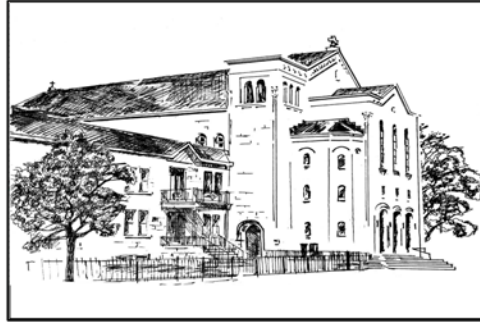

### Feast of Christ the King

Week by week the Liturgy has been preparing us for the revelation to be made on this, the last Sunday of the Church year.

Jesus, we have been shown, is truly the Chosen One, the Messiah of God, the King of Jews. Ironically, in today's Gospel we hear these names on the lips of those who don't believe in Him - Israel's rulers, the soldiers, a criminal dying alongside

Him. They can only see the scandal of a bloodied figure nailed to a cross. They scorn Him in words and gestures foretold in Israel's Scriptures. If He is truly King, God will rescue Him they taunt; but He did not come to save Himself, He came to save them - and us.

By the blood of His cross, Jesus reveals His Kingship. His Kingdom is the Church, the new Jerusalem and House of David that we sing of in today's Psalm. By their covenant with David, Israel's tribes are made one "bone and flesh" with their king. By the new covenant made in His blood, Christ becomes one flesh with the people of His Kingdom - the Church (see [Ephesians 5:23-32](#)).

We celebrate and renew this covenant in every Eucharist, giving thanks for our redemption, hoping for the day when we too will be with Him in Paradise.
