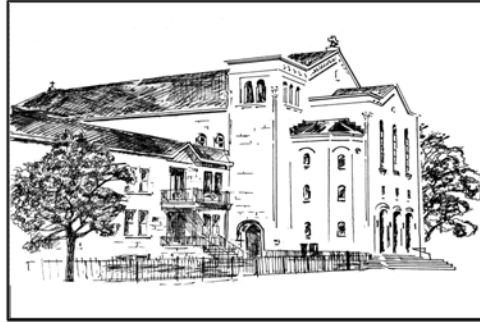

Novena to St. Willibrord

In the Catholic Church, a novena is a devotion consisting of prayers repeated on nine consecutive days, asking to obtain special graces. They are usually prayers of petition but sometimes are prayers of thanksgiving. The nine days recall the nine days that the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary spent in prayer between [Ascension Thursday](#) and [Pentecost Sunday](#).

THE OLDEST NOVENA

The Novena in honour of the Holy Spirit is the oldest of all the novenas since it was first made at the direction of Our Lord Himself when He sent His apostles back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Spirit on the first Pentecost.

It is still the only novena officially prescribed by the Church. Addressed to the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, it is a powerful plea for the light and strength, and, love so sorely needed by every Christian.

This year in appreciation for the intercessions of our patron, St. Willibrord these past 100 years, we began praying a Novena on Friday, Nov. 1st continuing nightly at 7:00 pm, culminating with his feast day which we will celebrate next Sunday at Mass. Please join us!
