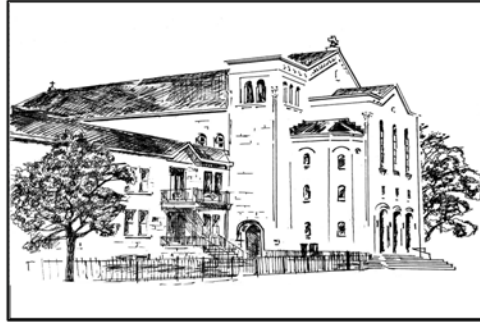

The purpose of this Verdun coalition is to work together on joint projects and multiply the number of options available for young people to get involved by pooling our resources. Our inaugural event is tentatively schedule for either Nov 16 or Nov 23. This date is to be confirmed. Regrettably I have been unable to attend Mass at our parish the last 3 weeks because of other commitments, but rest assured that youth ministry is going to happen at our parish.
